DIRT MADE MY LUNCH (Ages 6-12 June 13 - 15, 9-1pm

Come learn about the flora and fungi that sustain us and the ecosystem,



and all the ways they benefit our lives. We will get our hands dirty in the garden, learning about different plant parts, how plants transform solar energy into chemical energy, and how we can help plants grow with sustainable (and regenerative) practices.



HOWLERS (Ages 6-12) June 27 - 29, 9-1pm

Can you howl like a coyote or walk like a fox? Explore with our local foothill
mammals! Learn to identify animal trails,

tracks, scat and more! Examine different mammal skulls, teeth and adaptations. Feel the fur of our mammals big and small! Predator vs. Prey, who is best equipped to survive in the Sierra Foothills?

DINOSAUR DAYS: PREHISTORIC CREATURES (Ages 6-12) July 4 - 6, 9-1pm

Dinosaurs are everywhere - and not just on the land, but in the sea and in the air! And they're not just a thing of the past – dinosaur descendants may



be living in your backyard! Come learn about the prehistoric creatures that once roamed the land. We will investigate their behaviors, adaptations and habitats on ancient Earth.



GEOLOGY ROCKS (Ages 6-12) July 11 - 13, 9-1pm

Dig this! From earthquakes to erupting volcanoes, and meteorites to crystals, rocks

are all around us. We will dig into geological studies of the rock cycle, fossils and minerals, and how they have shaped the living world around us. Geology will rock your world!

WATER WORLDS: IN THE FLOW (Ages 6-12) July 18 - 20, 9-1pm

Immerse yourself in the world of water! We will learn about how humans are a part of the water cycle, and how we influence the Earth's most limited



resource. Exploring our local watershed, we gain insight into how we can help protect and conserve the water that gives us life. Our water fight is in the garden!

POLLINATORS, PESTS AND PREDATORS (Ages 6-12) June 20 - 22, 9-1pm

Do you know the order of the honeybee hive? Or what their dance means? Get your insect nets and bug viewers,



because we're going on a scavenger hunt! We will learn about life cycles, inspect insects and explore the pollinators' habitats. We'll also be learning about other important invertebrates: the predators and decomposers! We will trap insects to study but always release them.
